

The Kelper Hartley scholarships were established from the estate of the first Professor of French, Professor Kelper Hartley, at the University of Newcastle to promote the study of French and to assist students in this endeavour. Funding is derived from the Hartley Bequest administered by the executors, the Perpetual Trustees.

Kelper Hartley Bequest PhD Scholarship

The beneficiary of this scholarship will receive a stipend over the 3.5 years of a full-time PhD with 50% funded by the Kelper Hartley Bequest and 50% by the University.

Kelper Hartley Bequest International PhD Scholarship

It is proposed that the beneficiary of this international candidate scholarship will have his or her tuition fees and health cover paid over the 3.5 years of a full-time PhD with 50% funded by the Kelper Hartley Bequest and 50% by the University. A University funded stipend will also be provided with this scholarship.

Eligibility

To be eligible to apply for this scholarship you must meet the following criteria:

- enrolling full time in a PhD (Modern Languages), specifically French related research.

Required Documentation

Application form for admission and scholarship is required. Please write "Kelper Hartley Scholarship Application" on the top of the front page.

Selection

Selection of the scholar will be on the basis of academic merit.
