TimeTen tickets save up to 18% on bus travel

When travelling to and from the University with Newcastle Buses, you can save up to 18% by using TimeTen tickets instead of paying cash for each trip.

TimeTen tickets give you ten 1 hour trips. If you change buses within 1 hour of starting your trip, you still dip your TimeTen ticket in the green ticket machine on the bus but the machine does not register an additional trip.

TimeTen tickets can be bought on campus at Callaghan at:

Benefits of using TimeTen Tickets when you travel by bus.

- You save money on every trip - up to 18% on cash fares.
- You can board the bus more quickly, and don't have to wait in a queue to pay your fare.
- When you get on the bus, you simply dip the TimeTen ticket in the ticket machine. The machine prints the number of trips remaining on the ticket.
- There's no fiddling for cash for each trip, and no waiting for change.
- There's no extra fare when you change buses within an hour of starting your trip.
- The TimeTen ticket is valid for up to 10 trips - there is no expiry date for making the trips.
- There are convenient locations at the University and around Newcastle where you can buy TimeTen tickets when it suits you.
- Travelling to and from the University with a student TimeTen is around 35% cheaper than buying a day parking permit if you travel by car.
