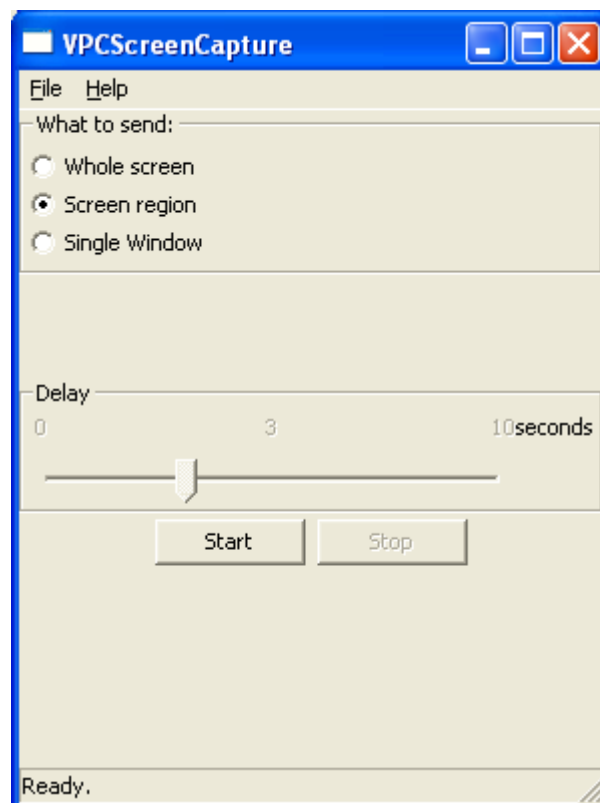


VPC Screen Capture

The VPC Screen Capture function allows you to send a portion (or all) of the screen as a video feed for remote collaborators to view. This is particularly useful for:

- Streaming of a PowerPoint or equivalent presentation
- Streaming a video/animation
- Streaming an unique application
- Streaming any particular item from your desktop to everyone else

When AG enters a venue the VPCScreenCapture window is displayed.



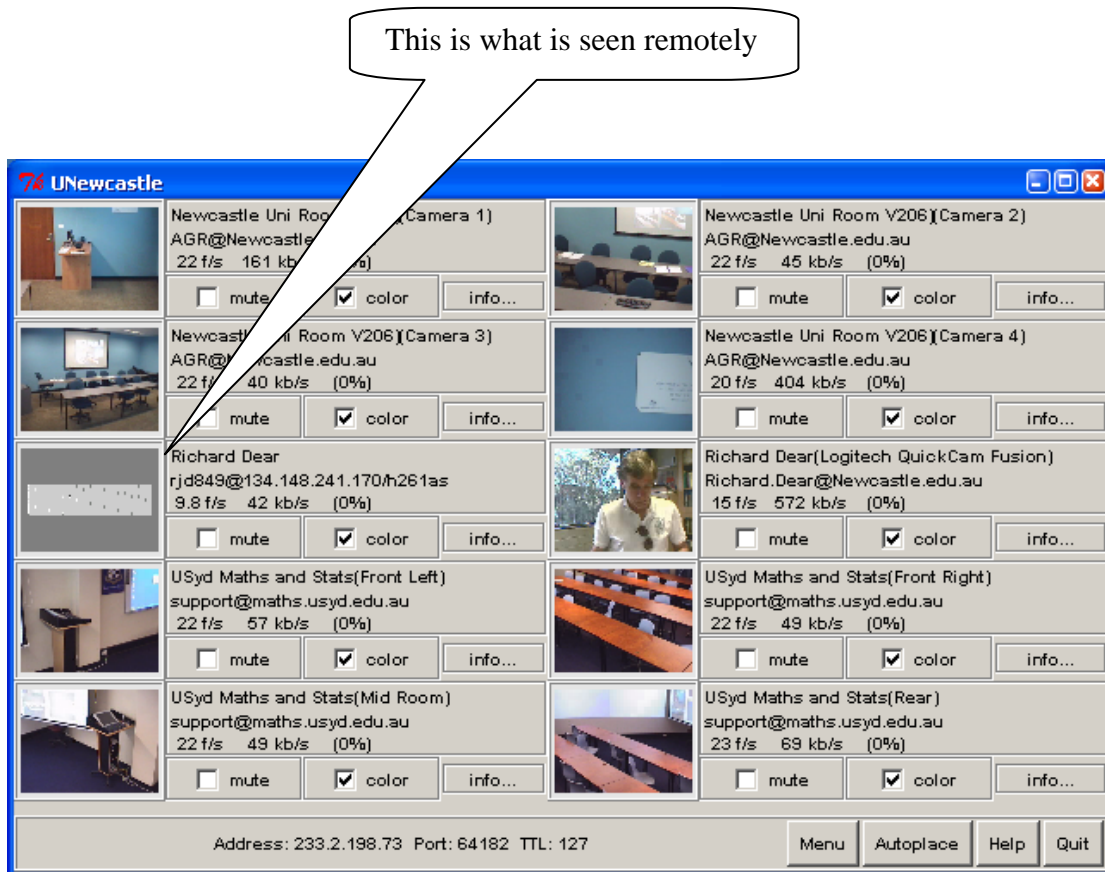
To utilize this feature you should select which part of the screen is to be sent (click the radio button) and then click “Start”

1. To send the whole screen you need do nothing except click the appropriate button and click “Start”. To view the feed yourself, find the window in the UNewcastle VIC window and click it. Be careful with this as you will find the screen fills up with copies, for as soon as you send an image, it generates another and the screen starts to look very messy. This won't be an issue at the remote end, however.
2. To send a screen region, Click the “screen region” button and then click “Start”. When you have done this, the cursor will turn into a cross-hair. Move the mouse the top left hand corner of the screen region you wish to transmit and, with the left button depressed, drag the cross-hair to

the lower right hand corner. Release the mouse button. As above, you can check what you are sending. This check is a little easier than above, repetition issue doesn't occur. Remember that you are sending a screen region and you must control what is displayed in that area of the screen.

3. To send a Single window is probably the most useful. Select the "Single Window" bullet and you will notice that the Delay bar is activated. You may select a delay factor before which you select the Screen window to be displayed remotely. After this delay the cursor will turn to a cross-hair and you may click the window you wish to have displayed remotely.

At the remote end the screen capture will appear as another VIC feed and can be clicked and moved like any of the normal camera feeds. Note that remote users have no control over your desktop.



When you have finished, click the "Stop" button and the feed will be stopped.
