

Cynthia D. Fisher received a Ph. D. Industrial/Organizational Psychology from Purdue University in 1978. She is Professor and Head of Management in the School of Business at Bond University and has previously held faculty posts at Texas A&M University, the University of Baltimore, and the National University of Singapore. Her research interests include affect at work, attitude--behaviour relationships, and work motivation. Dr. Fisher is the first author of Human Resource Management, a textbook now in its sixth edition with Houghton-Mifflin. She has served on the editorial boards of the Academy of Management Review, Journal of Applied Psychology, and Organizational Behavior and Human Decision Processes. Her research has been funded by large grants from the Office of Naval Research and the Australian Research Council. Dr. Fisher is a Fellow of the Society of Industrial and Organizational Psychology and is the recipient of two Carrick Citations for university teaching. She is currently serving a three-year term on the Australian Research Council's College of Experts for the Social, Behavioural, and Economic Sciences.
