In the Education component of the degree, students will undertake courses offered across four strands: Learners and Learning including Special Needs Education, Teachers and Teaching, Key Learning Area (KLA) Curriculum study and Professional Experience including research. The Arts component consists of some prescribed foundation courses for specific KLA study. At least 40 units should be undertaken in one particular KLA discipline or interdisciplinary study.
