To ensure that you have the most current information, this PEC should be read in conjunction with the Program Handbook: http://www.newcastle.edu.au/program/10435.html A load of 80 units per year (40 units per semester) for 3 years is the standard full-time load. Students must complete a minimum of 40 units and a maximum of 100 units of courses at each level (e.g. between 40 and 100 units of 1000 level courses, between 40 and 100 units of 2000 level courses, and between 40 and 100 units of 3000 level courses).
