Some things to note!!

*Some courses are offered in both the DIRECTED and MAJOR course lists. You can count these courses toward your directed OR your major, you **CANNOT** count them toward **BOTH**.

- Many politics POLI and economics ECON courses run at both 2nd and 3rd year level (same course, different assessment). In the majors you can take these courses either at the 2nd or the 3rd year level - whichever works best for you.
- To finish in three years you need to take 40 units per semester
- Not all courses are offered every year.

To satisfy the requirements for the B Development Studies you must complete 240 units comprising:

- 40 units of CORE courses at 1000 level
- 10 units of CORE courses at 3000 level (GEOG3300)
- At least 20 units of DIRECTED courses at 1000 level
- At least 30 units of DIRECTED courses at 2000 level
- At least one MAJOR sequence which comprises 80 units (40 units need to be at 3000 level)
- No more than 100 units can be taken at 1000 level
- At least 60 units must be taken at 3000 level
