TRANSITION ARRANGEMENTS

FOR STUDENTS WHO COMMENCED THE PROGRAM PRIOR TO 2012:

Core Courses

In 2012 CULT2130 has been replaced by FMCS2000. Students who have successfully completed CULT2130 can count it as a core course.

Media Studies Major

In 2012, several Directed Courses were removed from the Media Studies Major. Students who commenced the degree prior to 2012 are permitted to adhere to the previous Media Studies Major structure.

In 2012, CULT and FILM courses were re-coded as FMCS. Students who have already completed a CULT/FILM course that was part of the major will be able to count it toward their major.

Media Production Major

In 2012, several Directed Courses were removed from the Media Production Major. Students who commenced the degree prior to 2012 are permitted to adhere to the previous Media Production Major structure.

In 2012 AART1700 has replaced AART1400 and AART1410. Students who have successfully completed either AART1400 or AART1410 may count them towards their major.

In 2012, CULT and FILM courses have been re-coded as FMCS. Students who have already completed a CULT/FILM course that was part of the major will be able to count it toward their major.

Public Relations Major

In 2012, the Public Relations Major was revised to seek accreditation from the Public Relations Institute of Australia (PRIA). Students who commenced the degree prior to 2012 are permitted to take the previous Public Relations major structure, or can take the revised Public Relations major by selecting courses that fulfil requirements of the revised major.

Students who have already successfully completed CMNS3480 can not count CMNS2500 towards their degree.

Students who have already successfully completed CMNS2290 can not count CMNS3530 towards their degree.

FOR STUDENTS WHO COMMENCED THE PROGRAM PRIOR TO 2011:

CMNS1110 has been replaced by CMNS1234. Students who have successfully completed CMNS1110 can count it as a core course.

Students who successfully completed CMNS2060:

- can count it towards the Journalism Major or Media Production Major

Students who successfully completed CMNS3300

- can count it towards the Journalism major; and
- are not permitted to enrol in CMNS3333
