External Senior Academic Reviewers

Professor Peter Sullivan has extensive experience in research and teaching in teacher education and is currently Professor of Science, Mathematics and Technology Education at Monash University. He was a teacher for 10 years and worked in schools and universities in Papua New Guinea for 6 years. He was a member of the Social, Behavioural and Economic Sciences (SBE) panel of the Australian Research Council College of Experts from 2005 to 2008, and was an editor of the Journal of Mathematics Teacher Education for 8 years. He is the current President of the Australian Association of Mathematics Teachers and was the lead writer of the Australian Curriculum: Mathematics.

Emeritus Professor Breakspere is a Physical Chemist who started his academic career at the University of Wales, Cardiff, UK. He was Foundation Professor of Chemical Technology and Dean, Faculty of Science at UTS before appointment as Pro Vice Chancellor (Research and External Development) at Central Queensland University. Professor Breakspere was President of the Australian Institute of Nuclear Science and Engineering (1995-96), a member of the ARC Institutional Grants Committee and is, at present, a member of the Appeals Committee of the ARC. He is the Director of Breakspere Consulting and has undertaken a number of consultancies for the ARC on Research Profiles and the Effect of ARC Funding on Long Term Research and is a consultant to a number of companies worldwide.
